


A successful Maitland Uniting Churches Planning Consultation Workshop was held on Sunday 30 March at Morpeth Uniting Church. The session was led by Rev. Dr Rod Pattenden and Rev Garry Derkenne. Bolwarra had four representatives with good representation from the other congregations. The workshop looked at where we have come since we started coming together with the successful formation of a regional council and task groups focusing on worship, property, finance and *MUNCH. We have employed staff and improved our administration and capacity for mission. We looked at what we are doing currently in the community and individuals shared stories of where they had seen God at work in their lives, their church or the community. We are now working together on new initiatives that we could develop with some great ideas put forward. Another three meetings will be held this year; all will be held at Morpeth from 2-4pm.
